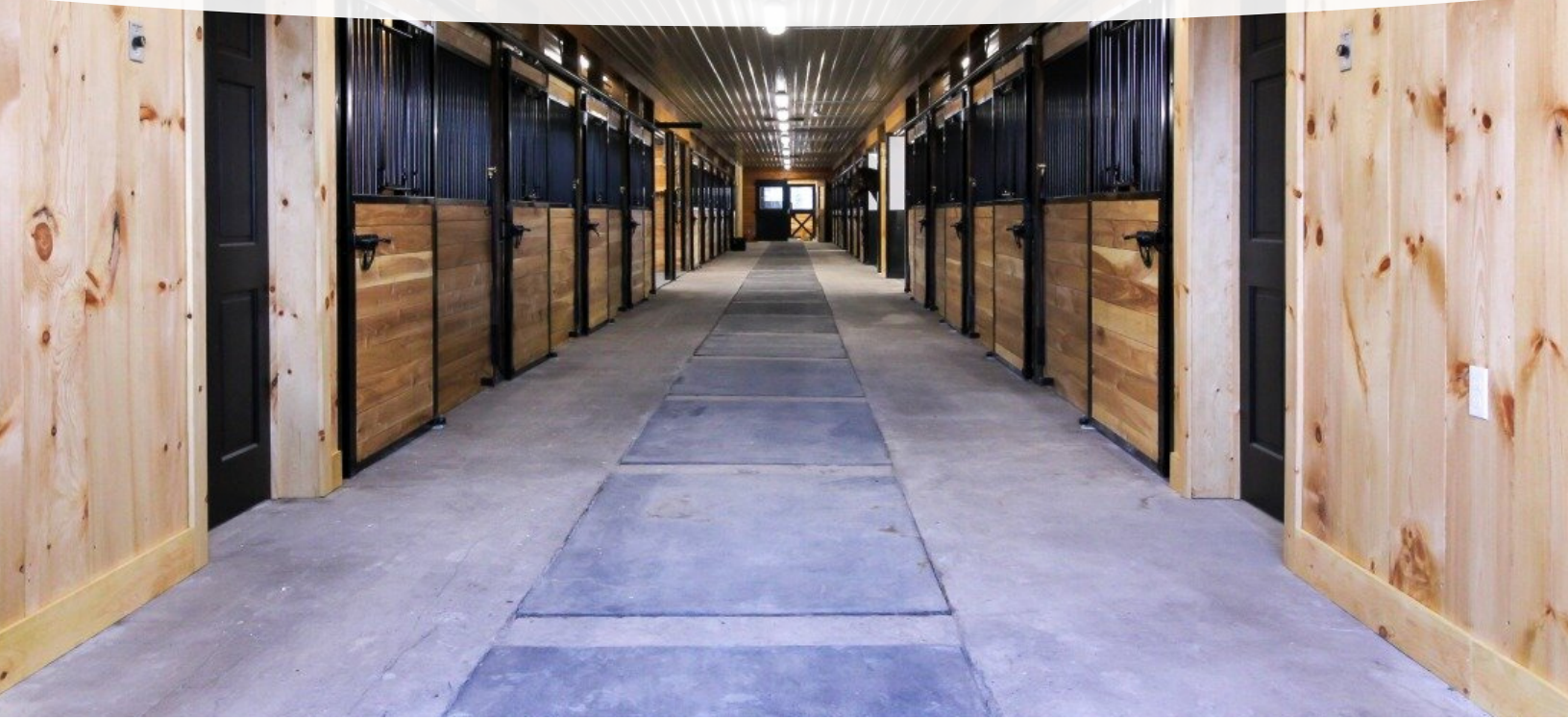

Internship Requirements: Must have passing score on the NAVLE, be eligible for a veterinary license in Ontario, DVM or VMD degree from an accredited university, possess a valid drivers license, and have completed an externship with us.
