

Strong interest in equine veterinary medicine. Graduate of a veterinary medicine program at an AVMA accredited school and a passing score on the NAVLE; veterinary licenses to practice in New Zealand and the United States or Canada; must qualify for viable visa.

All required international work visas, travel expense reimbursement for rotation abroad, work vehicle, competitive intern salary, reimbursement for licensing and accreditation in both countries, Altano benefits, and CE opportunities through Altano Academy.

Application Process:
