Internship Requirements: Completing an Externship at Moore Equine prior to application for an internship is highly recommended. Applications are due October 15. Please submit a Letter of Intent, your CV, three letters of reference, and a copy of your transcripts (unofficial copies are accepted) to internship@mooreequine.ca to apply.
