Elder's Equine Veterinary Service began as a solo practitioner mobile practice and has since grown into a full-service equine medical, advanced imaging, and surgical referral centre for the province of Manitoba. We are a seven-veterinarian practice with boarded specialists in equine surgery and anesthesiology.

Our hospital has 14 stalls, an operating room, indoor arena, and rehabilitation and reproduction facilities. The recently renovated main practice facility offers the first year-round lameness center in Manitoba, and we are fully equipped with DR radiography, digital ultrasound, MRI, standing CT, PRP/IRAP, in-house blood analysis, shockwave, PENS, video endoscopy, and ICU capabilities.

Roughly thirty minutes from Winnipeg, an opportunity at Elder's Equine has every modern convenience without the need to sacrifice the desire for year-round adventure.

Externship and Summer Internship Requirements: Applicant must be a student of a College of Veterinary Medicine.

Internship Requirements: Applicant must have a DVM or equivalent, eligibility for licensure in Manitoba, ability to qualify for a Manitoba Horse Racing Commission license, and CFIA Accreditation eligibility. An externship is not required, but recommended.
